

Queueing at Wimbledon 2023 Guide

START: 2 JULY 2023 AT 2 PM



ARRIVE AT WIMBLEDON PARK



The Queue starts in Wimbledon Park. If you're entering the Grounds during the early or late evening, you'll need to use Wimbledon Park Road gates, which is a 5-minute walk from Southfields Station.



There are experienced Stewards available 24 hours a day to help and guide you. You can ask them about any aspects regarding queueing and information on The Championships. The Stewards operate a Code of Conduct for The Queue and will arbitrate in any dispute.



JOIN THE QUEUE

Proceed to the end of The Queue (look for a flag that identifies the end of the queue!)



GET A QUEUE CARD

When you arrive at the queue, you will be issued a **QUEUE CARD**



Dated and numbered card that shows your position in The Queue.



Keep it with you until you manage to buy the ticket.



Strictly non-transferable.

STAYING OVERNIGHT?

Where and How?



Camp at Wimbledon Park: there are toilet facilities, refill water stations, and First Aid provision.



Only two-person tents are permitted.



No Loud music.



Bags that need to be stored in Left Luggage must not exceed 60cm x 45 cm x 25cm in size.



No gazebos, barbecues, camping stoves, or fires.



No smoking or vaping.



No excessive consumption of alcohol.



Please be considerate to residents by keeping noise to a minimum.

Fold-up chair



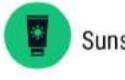

EARLY MORNING PROCEDURES



6:00 AM

Wake up, pack your camping equipment, and form a queue. Take the overnight equipment to Left Luggage Facility.



7:30 AM

Wristbands will be issued to people queueing for Centre, No.1, and No.2 Court tickets.



LUGGAGE



From 5.30 am until one hour after play ends for the day.



Overnight equipment, oversized bags, picnic hampers, and other prohibited items are left at Left Luggage 'A' facility: **£5 each**.



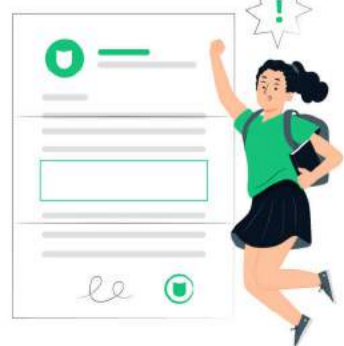
Left Luggage bag size restriction of 60cm x 45cm x 25cm: **£1 each**
